Department 02-Junior Dairy Cattle

NEW FOR 2025

This will be a heifer show only, no cow classes. All breeds will show together according to age.

(If entries increase, we would consider splitting classes by breed again in future years)

- ◆ The Platteville Dairy Days Dairy Cattle Show is open to youth no more than 21 years old as of January 1 of the exhibit year. There are NO geographical limitations for dairy cattle exhibitors. Membership in 4-H, FFA or breed association is NOT required.
- ◆ In addition to the \$5.00 exhibitor fee, there will be a \$1.00/head entry fee.
- ◆ Cattle must be in place by 11:00 am with the show starting at 12:00 (Noon) on Saturday September 6, 2025. Cattle will be released at 4:00 p.m.
- ◆ Registered and grade animals will be shown together.
- ◆ There is no electricity or wash racks available. There will be drinking water available for the cattle.
- ◆ All bedding MUST be picked up following the show.
- ◆ No person shall exhibit any animal afflicted with or exposed to any contagious or infectious disease.

- ◆ Premise ID and individual animal ID must be listed on the entry form.
- ◆ Danish System judging will be used for breed classes.

1. Heifer Class, exhibitor 2nd grade & under, heifer fall yearling & under (all breeds show together)
2. Spring Heifer Calf (Born on or after Mar. 1, 2025)
3. Winter Heifer Calf (Born between Dec. 1, 2023 & Feb. 28, 2024)
4. Fall Heifer Calf (Born between Sept. 1 & Nov. 30, 2024)
5. Summer Yearling (Born between June 1 & Aug. 31, 2024)
6. Spring Yearling (Born between Mar. 1 & May 31, 2024)
7. Winter Yearling (Born between Dec. 1 2022 & Feb. 28, 2024)
8. Fall Yearling (Born between Sept. 1 & Nov. 30, 2023)

First and second place heifer class winners will show for Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion.

Lots-Showmanship (grade as of January 1)

9. Kiddie Class (Grade 2 & Under)
10. Beginner (Grade 3 & 4)
11. Junior (Grade 5 & 6)
12. Intermediate (Grade 7 & 8)
13. Senior (Grade 9 & Over)
